How was the Grant spent?

The grant went towards a purchase of Mini Tennis Red, Orange, and Green Tennis balls and 8 large Plastic cones for our junior section of the club. The balls are special pressure less balls designed for mini-tennis to make playing easier for the younger children (Red (U8s), Orange (U10), Green (U12)).

Was the project successful? Give a summary of the project outcome.

We are completing a large £56,000 court resurfacing project (this week). As a result of the cost of this large project we have been making use of very old balls for the last two years as one of our cost saving exercises. They are not fit for purpose anymore, the felt has worn down and they are not bouncing as they should. Additionally, we have not been able to replace some of our large cones that have broken as they were nearly 10 years old. The new balls and equipment mean the junior tennis sessions, matches, and coaching sessions that the club run will be enhanced and made easier for the children.

What impact has the project had on people involved / the local community?

These balls (equipment) allow younger children to find it easier to come into the sport and learn the skills. Providing opportunities for young children to play sport and maintain their enjoyment of it so they continue playing is very important for their physical development and general wellbeing. The balls and equipment will help make the learning experience more fun, resulting in children continuing to want to play the sport
